

C H A P . 2 5

An Act to amend article 3488 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and article 346 of the Code of Civil Procedure, with regard to stenographers.

(Assented to 16th March, 1916)

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 3488 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, as follows : R.S., 3488, am.

“The stenographers so furnished shall be officers of the Superior Court, and subject to its control, but they shall be chosen by the parties.” Officers of the court.

2. Article 346 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, as follows : C.C.P., art. 346, am.

“It shall be the duty of the stenographer to read out his notes whenever required so to do by the judge.” Notes to be read.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

C H A P . 2 6

An act to amend the act 3 George V, chapter 38, relating to the protection of certain municipalities against fire.

[Assented to 9th March, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 3822j of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 3 George V, chapter 38, section 1, is amended by replacing the words: “ten thousand” in the second and third lines thereof, by the words: “twenty-five thousand.” en-3822j, R.S., am.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
