

## C H A P . 2 5

An Act to amend article 3488 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and article 346 of the Code of Civil Procedure, with regard to stenographers.

*(Assented to 16th March, 1916)*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 3488 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, as follows : R.S., 3488, am.

“The stenographers so furnished shall be officers of the Superior Court, and subject to its control, but they shall be chosen by the parties.” Officers of the court.

**2.** Article 346 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, as follows : C. C. P., art. 346, am.

“It shall be the duty of the stenographer to read out his notes whenever required so to do by the judge.” Notes to be read.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

## C H A P . 2 6

An act to amend the act 3 George V, chapter 38, relating to the protection of certain municipalities against fire.

*[Assented to 9th March, 1916]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 3822j of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 3 George V, chapter 38, section 1, is amended by replacing the words: “ten thousand” in the second and third lines thereof, by the words: “twenty-five thousand.” en-3822j, R.S., am.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
