An Act to amend the act 4 George V, chapter 42, relating to stationary engineers.

[Assented to 16th March, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R.S. 3866*n*,
enacted.

1. The Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended by inserting therein, after article 3866*m*, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 42, section 1, a new article, 3866*n*, as follows:

required of
a stationary
engineer.

“3866*n*. 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, whether general or special, or any order or resolution, or any by-law passed thereunder by a municipality, no stationary engineer who has complied with this section, who has passed his examination before the board of examiners or the examiners, and has obtained a certificate of competence, shall be bound to pass any other examination or to obtain any license or certificate of competence from any municipal authority.

2. All provisions incompatible with this article shall have no force or effect, and are hereby repealed; and no municipality may avail itself thereof, in any manner whatsoever, to require an examination, a license or a certificate of competence, in order to qualify a person to take charge of any installation of motive power.”

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 28

An Act to amend the Notarial Code.

[Assented to 9th March, 1916]

1. Article 4707 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by replacing the word : “ six ”, in the third line thereof, by the word: “ ten ”.
