CHAP. 31

An Act to amend the Quebec Insurance Act with regard
to insurance agents.

[Assented to 16th March, 1916]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended by inserting R.S., 6961a
therein, after article 6961 thereof, new articles 6961a and and 6961b,
