

## C H A P . 3 2

An Act to amend the Civil Code respecting the enjoyment of civil rights.

[Assented to 9th March, 1916]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C.C., art.  
20, am.

**1.** Article 20 of the Civil Code is amended by striking out the words: "or grandfather by the father's side," in the third line thereof.

C.C., art.  
22, replaced.

**2.** Article 22 of the Civil Code is replaced by the following:

Conditions  
of natural-  
ization.

**"22.** The conditions of naturalization are determined by the Federal laws on that subject passed by the Parliament of Canada within the limits of its legislative jurisdiction."

Coming into  
force.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## C H A P . 3 3

An Act to amend article 1342 of the Civil Code.

[Assented to 16th March, 1916]

**H**IS Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C.C., art.  
1342, am.

**1.** Article 1342 of the Civil Code, as amended by the act 4 George V, chapter 62, section 1, is again amended by striking out the words: "in order to prevent the continuation of the community", at the end of the said article.

Coming into  
force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
