

liminary examinations for admission to study dental surgery only in September, 1914, he would in the ordinary course be obliged to wait four years from this date before being permitted to practise as a dentist in this Province;

That he is qualified in every way to practise as a dentist in the Province of Quebec and that it would be a hardship to compel him to wait four years from September, 1914;

That the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec have approved of the passing of an act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit the petitioner as a member to practise dentistry in the said Province of Quebec;

Whereas the petitioner has, by his petition, prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Moe Newton Fineberg among its members and to grant him the necessary license for the practice of dental surgery in the Province.

CHAP. 124

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit J. B. Frederic Houde among its members.

[Assented to 16th March, 1916]

Preamble.

WHEREAS J. B. Frederic Houde, of the city and district of Montreal, student, has by his petition represented:

That he is 26 years old;

That in the month of September, 1909, he was matriculated as a student of dental surgery at Laval University, in Montreal;

That he followed the course of lectures of that school for the four regulation university years;

That in April, 1915, he passed his university examinations and was awarded the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery;

That in September, 1910, he presented himself before the board of examiners of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, to pass the examination for admission to the study of dental surgery, and passed for the 'Letters' part of the said examination;

That later, in September, 1915, he presented himself again before the examiners of the said college, to complete the necessary examinations for admission to the study of dental surgery, and that he then passed the said examination for the 'Sciences' part, and was regularly admitted to the study of dental surgery;

That owing to his studies and his qualifications and probation, the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has consented to the passing of an act to authorize the said college to grant the petitioner a license to practise his profession after an examination on primary and final subjects;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said J. B. Frederic Houde among its members, and to grant him the necessary license for the practice of dental surgery in the Province, after examination on primary and final subjects.

CHAP. 125
