

CHAP. 37

An Act to amend the acts respecting the Board of Roman Catholic School Commissioners of the city of Quebec.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

WHEREAS the Board of Roman Catholic School Commissioners of the city of Quebec has, by its petition, represented: Preamble.

That it is necessary that the Board of Roman Catholic School Commissioners of the city of Quebec contract new loans for the purpose of erecting new school houses, for providing furniture for them and for completing the present school houses generally;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 87, as ^{6 Ed. VII,} replaced by the acts 8 Edward VII, chapter 32, section ^{c. 87, s. 1,} 1, and 3 George V, chapter 28, section 3, is again replaced ^{replaced.} by the following:

“**1.** The Roman Catholic Board of School Commissioners of the city of Quebec, notwithstanding the provisions to the contrary contained in section 35 of the act 32 Victoria, chapter 16, may, for the purpose of building, enlarging and improving school houses in the city of Quebec, issue, from time to time, according to the needs of the board, bonds, redeemable in fifty years at the latest, by annuities or semi-annuities, or in any other manner which the board may deem advisable, provided the whole amount of the said debt shall not exceed one million and a half dollars. Loan authorized.”

Nervertheless the said commissioners may in any other way temporarily borrow any part of the amount herein ^{Temporary loans.} authorized, provided the amount do not exceed one hundred thousand dollars.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into force.} sanction.
