

C H A P . 4 6

An Act respecting the school commissioners of the municipality of the parish of Ste. Madeleine d'Outremont, in the county of Montreal-Westmount.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

WHEREAS the school commissioners of the municipal-^{Preamble.}
ity of the parish of Ste. Madeleine d'Outremont, in the county of Montreal-Westmount, have, by their petition, represented:

That they have built a school house for boys and girls at the corner of Lajoie and Champagneur streets, the plans whereof were duly approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction;

That they were authorized to borrow the amounts then deemed necessary for building the centre part and one of the wings of the said building, but that such sums have since been found insufficient to pay for the work;

That, acting in the interest of their municipality, they made a contract with the contractor then doing the work to build the remainder of the edifice;

That, in the partial performance thereof, work was done and a quantity of materials delivered on the spot;

That, owing to stagnation of business, and to the fact that the number of ratepayers consequently ceased to increase, they realize that they can delay the erection of the new part of the building for some years;

That, however, the work done and the materials delivered on the spot are exposed to lose much of their value unless they are properly protected from inclement weather;

That the balance due on the finished part of the building is seventeen thousand dollars, and that an additional amount of twenty-three thousand dollars is required to pay for and preserve the work in the part under construction, to pay the cost of this act and other expenses;

That it is just that such amounts be levied, paid and expended for the above purposes;

Whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The school commissioners of the municipality of the parish of Ste. Madeleine d'Outremont, in the electoral^{Loan au-}
district of Montreal-Westmount, are hereby authorized^{thorized.} to borrow an amount not exceeding forty thousand dollars, whereof seventeen thousand dollars shall be used in paying the balance due on the completed part of the

said Lajoie school, and twenty-three thousand dollars shall be used for the payment in full of the work done and materials supplied for the part of the building under construction, as well as for the preservation of the said work and materials, and for the payment of the cost of this act, and also the costs due on the contestation of this act by the interested parties, and all those incurred for the inquiry held by the Superintendent of Public Instruction in connection with this matter; provided that the payments to be made out of the latter sum of twenty-three thousand dollars, be previously approved by the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Bonds or debentures. **2.** Such loan shall be effected by means of bonds or debentures, with or without annuities as may be found preferable; it shall be repayable within a period not exceeding forty years, and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum, and be exempt from the authorization mentioned in articles 2727 and 2728 of the Revised Statutes, 1909.

Annual assessment. **3.** The school commissioners of the municipality of the parish of Ste. Madeleine d'Outremont, in the county of Montreal-Westmount, are authorized to levy annually, during forty years, upon the taxable property of the municipality, an amount sufficient to pay the interest and a sinking fund of not less than one per cent on the capital of the said loan, which sinking fund shall be administered by the said commissioners as required by the Education Act of the Province of Quebec.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 4 7

An Act to amend the act 3 George V, chapter 80, respecting the school municipality of Côte-des-Neiges.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

Preamble. **W**HEREAS Xavier Cardinal, gardener; Arthur Yale, farmer; Victor Cardinal, farmer; Camille Legaré, gardener; Hormisdas Desrosiers, farmer, and James McKenna, gardener, all of the city and district of Montreal, have, by their petition, represented that they are owners of land under cultivation in Mount Royal ward of the city of Montreal;
