

C H A P . 5 3

An Act to amend the act respecting juvenile delinquents.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S. 3290*h*,
am. **1.** Article 3290*h* of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as enacted by the act 1 George V (1st session), chapter 26, section 1, is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, as follows:

Certain powers granted to clerk of and deputy-clerk of court of Juvenile Delinquents. “In case of the absence or inability to act of the judge of the Juvenile Delinquents’ Court, by reason of illness or otherwise, the clerk or the deputy-clerk of such court may, in their respective qualities, conduct all proceedings and perform all acts in connection therewith—except the rendering of judgment and pronouncing of sentence—in connection with offences coming within the jurisdiction of the Court and the legislative authority of the Province.”

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 5 4

An Act to amend article 3408 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and to exempt practising architects from serving as jurors.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S. 3408,
am. **1.** Article 3408 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by inserting therein, after paragraph 8 thereof, a new paragraph, as follows:

Architects. “8*a*. Practising architects;”.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
