

CHAP. 55

An Act to amend the act respecting coroners in the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended by inserting therein, after article 3484 thereof, as enacted by the act 4 George V, chapter 38, section 1, a new article, as follows:

"3484a. No coroner shall order an internal or external examination of a body on which an investigation is held under article 3484, unless he has first made a declaration in writing, which shall be filed with the report of the investigation, stating that such internal or external examination is necessary to ascertain whether in the circumstances therein set forth, the death of the deceased is really the result of violence or unfair means, or culpable or negligent conduct of others, under circumstances such as will probably require the holding of a coroner's inquest."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 56

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, relating to judicial statistics.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 3577 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by replacing the words: "in the month of February", in the second and third lines thereof, by the words: "before the first day of June".

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
