

C H A P . 7 2

An Act to amend article 7442 of the Revised Statutes, 1909,
relating to declarations of partnership.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 7442 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by the act 2 George V, chapter 42, section 2, is replaced by the following:

"7442. Every member of a partnership, or person doing business under a co-partnership style, failing to comply with the provisions of this section, and every married person doing business as a trader, whether alone or in partnership with others, failing to comply with the provisions of the third paragraph of article 1834 of the Civil Code, is liable to a fine of not more than one hundred dollars, to be recovered before any court of competent civil jurisdiction by any person suing therefor. Penalty for not complying with provisions of this section and of C.C. 1834.

One half of such fine belongs to the Crown, for the uses of the Province, and the other half to the party suing the same, unless the suit be brought on behalf of the Crown alone, or in its name, in which case the whole of the penalty belongs to the Crown, for the uses aforesaid. Application of penalty.

As to all other procedure, the provisions of the law respecting penal actions apply to suits for penalties under this section. Provisions applicable.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
