

## C H A P . 81

An Act to amend article 15 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C. P., art. 15, am. **1.** Article 15 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the acts 62 Victoria, chapter 52, section 1, 9 Edward VII, chapter 73, section 2, and 1 George V (1st session), chapter 42, section 1, is again amended by adding to paragraph 4 thereof, the words: "or discontinuance".

## C H A P . 82

An Act to amend articles 112 and 1317 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C. P., 112, am. **1.** Article 112 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by inserting therein, after the words: "occupation and," in the third line thereof, the words: "the street and number of the ordinary residence in a city, as well as the".

C.C.P., 1317, am. **2.** Article 1317 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, as follows:

"When a registration division is situated partly in one district and partly in another, the registers intended for use in the registry office of such division, may also be paged, paraphed, attested and signed by the prothonotary of the Superior Court of either of such districts".

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
