An Act to regularize the clerkship of Joseph St. Pierre,
student-at-law.

[Assented to 5th March, 1915]

WHEREAS Joseph St. Pierre, student-at-law, of St. Preamble.
Paul d'Abbotsford, district of St. Hyacinthe, has,
by petition, represented:

That he holds a diploma of Bachelor of Sciences from Laval University, dated the 9th September, 1912, and that on the 17th of the same month and year, he was indentured to Mr. D. A. Léonard, notary, of Montreal, which indenture was registered on the following day, in the office of the secretary of the Board of Notaries, in Montreal, under the No. 1237 Vol. III, of indentures and transfers of indentures;

That, since the date of his indenture, he has assiduously worked in the office of the said notary, and has followed the course of lectures of the faculty of law at Laval University for the years 1912-1913 and 1913-1914;

That, during the months of June and July, 1913, he was seriously ill, under a physician's care, and that it was physically impossible for him to be present at the session of the Board of Notaries in 1913, immediately following the date of his indenture, for the purpose of applying for admission to study the notarial profession and the passing of a resolution giving retroactive effect to his indenture;

That he was admitted to the study of the notarial profession at the session of the Board of Notaries in 1914;

That he has obtained the authorization of the Board of Notaries to present a bill for the purpose of having his clerkship date back to that of his indenture;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the above purposes, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The clerkship of Joseph St. Pierre, student-at-Clerkship
law, of St. Paul d'Abbotsford, shall date back to the date regularized.
of his indenture, the 17th September, 1912, although he
did not apply for admission to the study of the notarial
profession at the session of the Board of Notaries imme-
diately following the date of his indenture.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
