CHAP. 8

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, relating to the closing of taverns.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 1329 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as re- R. S. 1329 placed by the act 1 George V (1st session), chapter 10, amended. section 13, is amended:

*a.* By inserting therein, before the words "seven o'clock" in the ninth line thereof, the words "half-past";

*b.* By replacing the words "or Good Friday" in the tenth and eleventh lines thereof, by the words "Good Friday, Confederation Day and Labor Day."

**2.** Article 1333 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended: *Id.* 1333 am.

*a.* By inserting therein, after the word "bars" in the twelfth line thereof, the words: "or rooms in which liquor is trafficked in";

*b.* By replacing the third paragraph thereof, by the following:

"On Sundays and on the days mentioned in article 1329, the said bars and rooms in which intoxicating liquor is sold shall be completely closed in conformity with the provisions of the said article."

**3.** This act shall come into force on the first day of Coming into force. May 1914.
