CHAP. 27

An Act to amend the act to incorporate the school for higher commercial studies at Montreal.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec; enacts as follows:

1. The act 7 Edward VII, chapter 23, is amended by adding thereto, after article 19 thereof, a new article, as follows: 74Ed. VII,
ch. 23, s. 19a
enacted.

"19a. The corporation may affiliate its school with Laval University at Montreal, on conditions to be arranged between the corporation and the Governors of Laval University at Montreal. May affiliate
with Laval
University at
Montreal.

The arrangement establishing such affiliation shall come into force only after the publication in the *Quebec Official Gazette* of a notice to the effect that the said arrangement has been approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the recommendation of each of the two Committees of the Council of Public Instruction". Coming into
force of such
arrangement.

2. The act 7 Edward VII, chapter 23 is amended by adding after article 21, the following article: Id., s. 21a
enacted.

"21a. An accountant's diploma, granted in the way hereafter indicated confers on its holder, notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the right to become a member of the Association of Accountants in Montreal, or of the Institute of Accountants and Auditors of the Province of Quebec, without passing the examinations generally required, and after payment of the usual fees and contributions. Privileges

Before the diploma is granted, it must be demonstrated that the student is of the full age of twenty-one years, that he has followed the courses prescribed by the corporation for three years, that he has attended as a clerk, during his course and during twelve months immediately after leaving the school, the office of one of the members of the Conditions
on which
diploma is
granted.

association or institute, and that he has successfully passed the final examination before a jury composed of two professors of the above-mentioned corporation, a member of the association and a member of the institute.

Manner of nomination of delegates.

It shall be the duty of the association and of the institute to nominate their delegates on the jury by a resolution which must be transmitted to the corporation as soon as the latter shall have given them notice, a month in advance, by registered mail, of the place, date and hour of the examination.

Consent of three members required to pass.

The consent of three of the members of the jury shall be necessary to pass the student. If, however, the association or the institute, or both, fail to nominate its or their delegates, the consent of two members of the jury shall suffice to pass the student.

Proviso.

Signatures to diploma.

The diploma of accountant granted by the school shall be signed by the principal of the school and countersigned by the president and secretary of the Association of Accountants in Montreal and of the Institute of Accountants and Auditors of the Province of Quebec, as well as by the Provincial Secretary.

Proviso.

However, the signatures of the president and secretary of the association or of the institute, or of both, shall not be necessary if these corporations, or either of them, shall have failed to nominate their or its delegates.

Like privileges may be granted to another institution.

Nothing contained in this article shall prevent the same privileges being accorded by the association or institute to the Royal Institution for the advancement of Learning."

3. Article 22 of the act 7 Edward VII, chapter 23, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"This article shall not apply when the question is merely the granting of diplomas in accordance with the provisions of article 21a."

Coming into force.
