

## C H A P. 29

An Act to annex the school municipality of the town of Emard to that of the Catholic School Commission of Montreal.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

**W**HEREAS certain rate-payers of the municipality of the town of Emard, in the electoral districts of Jacques Cartier and Westmount, have, by their petition, represented that it is in their interest that their school municipality be annexed to that of the Catholic School Commission of Montreal, and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The school municipality of the town of Emard, in the electoral districts of Jacques Cartier and Westmount, is annexed to the school municipality under the jurisdiction and control of the Catholic School Commission of Montreal. School municipality annexed to Montreal Cath. School Commission.

**2.** From and after the date of such annexation the Catholic School Commission of Montreal shall succeed to the rights and obligations of the school commissioners for the municipality of the town of Emard, in the electoral districts of Jacques Cartier and Westmount, and the assets and liabilities of the latter shall be merged with the assets and liabilities of the said commission. Assets and liabilities transferred.

**3.** Without prejudice to the right of recourse to the courts of any creditor injured, the Catholic School Commission of Montreal may discuss, admit or reject any claim the payment of which is demanded from them as the successor to the school commission of the town of Emard, notwithstanding any acknowledgement or resolution of such corporation or its officers. Resolution or acknowledgement of the old commission not to bind the commissioners of Montreal re claims.

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
