An Act to grant to the Court of the district of Rimouski concurrent jurisdiction over certain parishes of the district of Gaspé.

[Assented to 19th February, 1194]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R.S. 3089 re-enacted. **1.** Article 3089 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, repealed by the act 1 George V (1st Session), chapter 9, section 9, paragraph F, is re-enacted, as follows :

Court of Rimouski given certain concurrent jurisdiction with court of Gaspé.

“**3089.** The court in the district of Rimouski has concurrent jurisdiction with the court of the district of Gaspé, over the parish of St. Norbert du Cap Chat and Ste. Anne des Monts, in the county of Gaspé.

Such concurrent jurisdiction extends to all the officials of the court.”

R. S. 3104 re-enacted. **2.** Article 3104 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, repealed by the act 1 George V (1st Session), chapter 9, section 9, paragraph F, is re-enacted, as follows :

Court of Rimouski given certain concurrent jurisdiction with court of Gaspé.

“**3104.** The court in the district of Rimouski has concurrent jurisdiction with the court of the district of Gaspé, over the parishes of St. Norbert du Cap Chat and Ste. Anne des Monts, in the county of Gaspé.

Such concurrent jurisdiction extends to all the officials of the court.”

Pending cases.

3. The cases and proceedings begun and pending at the time of the coming into force of this act, shall be continued, and the judgments to be rendered therein, as well as those already obtained, shall be executed as if the present act had not been passed.”

Coming into force.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
