An Act to incorporate *Hôpital Général St-Vincent de Paul de Sherbrooke*.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

WHEREAS Marie Justine Perras, in religion Sister Preamble.

Perras; Georgianna Morin, in religion Sister Marie de la Nativité; Marie Albertine Beauchemin, in religion Sister Beauchemin; Marie Massé, in religion Sister Massé; Marie Louise Dussault, in religion Sister Dussault, all of the city of Sherbrooke in the district of St. Francis, have, by their petition, represented that they wish to be incorporated under the name of "*Hôpital Général St. Vincent de Paul de Sherbrooke*" for the following among other purposes: to receive, care for, rear, board and educate sick and infirm persons, orphans, children and other persons, in their hospitals, houses and homes, and to devote themselves to charitable works generally;

And whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The said Marie Justine Perras, in religion Sister Corporation Perras; Georgianna Morin, in religion Sister Marie de la constituted. Nativité; Marie Albertine Beauchemin, in religion Sister Beauchemin; Marie Massé, in religion Sister Massé; Marie Louise Dussault, in religion Sister Dussault, all of the city of Sherbrooke, in the district of St. Francis, and all others who may become members of the said corporation, are incorporated under the name of "*Hôpital Général St. Vin- Name. cent de Paul de Sherbrooke.*"

2. The corporate seat of the corporation shall be in Corporate the city of Sherbrooke, in the district of St. Francis. seat.

3. The said corporation shall have perpetual succes- Corporate sion and may: powers.

- a. Have a seal which it may change or renew at will;
- b. Appear before the courts;
- c. Accept, hold and acquire moveable and immoveable property of any kind whatsoever, provided that the value of the immoveables held by the said corporation shall not exceed the sum of one million dollars;
- d. Borrow, lease, sell, exchange, transfer or otherwise

alienate their moveable and immoveable property, either wholly or in part, by any legal title, hypothecate its immoveables and become a party to bills of exchange or promissory notes;

e. Found and establish hospitals, asylums, homes and convents, erect all necessary buildings to that end, by complying with all formalities required by law;

f. Adopt by-laws for the admission, government and dismissal of its members, and the general administration of its property;

g. Appoint officers, procurators and administrators, and define their powers;

h. Train nurses and mothers' help and give such persons diplomas or certificates of competency as such, after all the formalities and conditions required for such purpose by its by-laws have been complied with.

4. The corporation shall, whenever thereunto required by the Provincial Secretary, transmit to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council a detailed statement of its moveable and immoveable property with the names of its officers and a certified copy of its rules and regulations.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 154

An Act respecting the Methodist Church.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Methodist Church has, by its petition, represented that the act 47 Victoria, chapter 50, should be amended, and it is expedient to grant the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the act 47 Victoria, chapter 50, is replaced by the following:

Vesting of

“2. As soon as the said act of incorporation shall come into force, all the property, real and personal, within the Province of Quebec, now belonging to or held in trust for, or to the use of the said denominations, or any of them,
