

All property, real or personal, shall be vested in the board of governors, which shall also have entire charge of all financial matters, except, of course, those which specially concern the individual colleges.

The Council or Senate.

The council or senate shall consist of the principals, professors and ten members of the board of governors (other than the principals) elected annually by that body. The Council have charge of academic matter such as the courses of study and examinations.

Each principal in turn, according to seniority of appointment as such, shall act as chairman for one year, and during his term of office shall be designated Dean.

The Faculty.

The principals and professors of the co-operating colleges shall constitute the faculty, which shall have charge of all questions relating to time-table of lectures, examinations and matters of discipline, and shall report its proceedings to the senate. The Dean shall be chairman.

Lecturers shall carefully avoid anything that might justly be considered distinctive denominational teaching.

An Act amend the act to incorporate *La Corporation Agricole et Industrielle des Missionnaires du St. Esprit*, and to change its name to that of "*Collège Apostolique Saint Alexandre de la Gatineau*."

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

WHEREAS *La Corporation Agricole et Industrielle des Missionnaires du Saint Esprit* Preamble.
has, by its petition, represented:

That it was incorporated by the act 9 Edward VII, chapter 144, for certain purposes set forth in the said act, under the name of "*La Corporation Agricole et Industrielle des Missionnaires du St. Esprit*";

That one of the chief objects of its organization consists in promoting the increase of the number of priests in countries where their number is insufficient, by means of the establishment of classical and theological colleges;

That certain dioceses, especially in the Canadian North West, have a pressing need of priests for the spiritual wants of the many Catholic immigrants who flock there;

That His Grace, the Archbishop of Ottawa, approves the request made by the petitioners to establish such work in Canada;

That it is necessary to amend the petitioners' charter to meet the wishes of its ecclesiastical superiors;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer to that effect contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of the act 9 Edward VII, chapter 144, is replaced by the following:

"**1.** The said fathers Henri Vanhaecke, Albert David, Joseph Dumont and Charles Démaison and the persons who may join or succeed them under the constitution and by-laws of the said *Congrégation du Saint Esprit*, are incorporated under the name of *Collège Apostolique Saint Alexandre de la Gatineau*".

2. Section 2 of the act 9 Edward VII, chapter 144, is replaced by the following:

"**2.** The corporation may:

1. Establish and maintain colleges or seminaries for imparting classical, philosophical and theological education;

2. Establish and maintain boarding and day schools for religious, industrial and agricultural instruction;

3. Teach young men agricultural and industrial arts, and, for the purpose of such teaching, establish, maintain and operate model farms, butter and cheese factories, grist-mills, saw-mills, and works for producing electricity;

4. Erect all buildings suitable for the above purposes;

5. Do everything necessary for the fulfilment of the objects aforesaid and all other things not contrary to law and authorized by the rules of the corporation of the community."

3. The change in name shall in no wise affect the rights, obligations and responsibilities contracted by the said corporation.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
