An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Albert J. McDonald among its members.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

WHEREAS Albert J. McDonald, of the city of Mont- Preamble.
real, hath by his petition represented:

That he took a course of classical studies at Loyola College in Montreal and at the Lycée Condorcet, Paris, France;

That in September, 1910, he began to study law in the office of Mr. J. L. Perron, K. C., of the city and district of Montreal, and that he continuously attended the said office until the month of June, 1913;

That in October, 1910, he entered the Faculty of Law at McGill University and there followed a regular course of law, and in May, 1913, received a degree of Bachelor of Civil Law, at the said University;

That in January, 1910, he successfully passed the examination of letters for admission to the study of law;

That in July, 1912, he successfully passed the examination of sciences for admission to the study of law;

That, following his admission to the study of law, he was indentured to the said J. L. Perron, K. C., by deed of indenture passed before L. A. Dérôme, N. P.;

That, in July, 1913, he successfully passed the examination for admission to the practice of law.

That he has obtained the approval of the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec to an act authorizing the said Bar to admit him to the practice of his profession and the secretary of the said Council to grant him his certificate as an advocate from the time of the sanctioning of the said act;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the above purposes; and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to permit the said Albert J. McDonald to practise as an advocate, and the secretary of the General Council of the Bar to issue to him his certificate as an advocate. Bar authorized to permit A. J. MacDonald to practice as advocate.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
