An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Maxime Morin to the practice of law.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Maxime Morin has, by his petition, represented that he followed a complete course of classical studies at Levis College;

That he followed a complete course of legal studies at Laval University in Quebec, where he obtained the diploma of Bachelor of Law;

That, under notarial indenture, he attended the office of Mr. Arthur Lachance, advocate, of Quebec, from September 1909 to January 1913;

That on the 6th July, 1912, he was admitted to the study of law by the Bar of the Province of Quebec;

That he successfully passed his examination for admission to the practice of law on the 5th July, 1913;

That the Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec has approved the passing of an act to authorize him to practise at once;

Whereas the said Maxime Morin has prayed for the passing of an act for the purposes hereinafter set forth; and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Bar of Quebec authorized to permit M. Morin to practice law.
Coming into force.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to permit Maxime Morin to practise the profession of advocate at once.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
