That the board of governors of the dental surgeons of the Province of Quebec have approved the passing of an act to authorize the college of dental surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit the petitioner as a member after final examinations for admission to practise;

Whereas the petitioner has, by his petition, prayed that an act to this effect be passed, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The college of dental surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Alonzo Wright McClelland among its members, and to grant him the necessary license to practise dental surgery in this Province, after examination for admission to practice.

## CHAP. 171

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit La Broquerie de la Bruère among its members.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

**W**HEREAS La Broquerie de la Bruère, surgeon dentist, now residing at Biddeford, Maine, has by his petition represented:

Preamble.

That he is forty-one years old and has followed a complete course of classical studies, with the exception of the last year of philosophy, at the Sherbrooke seminary;

That he obtained the degree of doctor of dental surgery from Tufts College Dental School, in Boston, on the 13th July, 1901;

That, on the 25th June, 1903, he obtained his license to practise in the State of Maine, and a similar license was granted him on the 10th June, 1903, to practise dental surgery in the State of New Hampshire;

That he has also been a member of the Maine Dental Society since the 23rd August, 1906, and also belongs to the York County Dental Club;

That from the day when he obtained his degrees at the Tufts College Dental School until he was licensed to

practise in the State of Maine, he worked in Lawrence, State of Massachusetts, under Doctor E. A. Roussel, dental surgeon, now practising in Montreal;

That he wishes to come back and live in the Province of Quebec where he was born, and has obtained the consent of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to the passing of an act authorizing the said college to grant him a license to practise his profession, after examination;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

## CHAP. 172

An Act to change the name of John Carson, of the city of Westmount, in the Province of Quebec, financial agent, to that of John Wallace Carson.

[Assented to 19th February, 1914]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS John Carson, of the city of Westmount, in the Province of Quebec, financial agent, hath, by his petition, set forth that he is desirous of having his name changed to John Wallace Carson so as to obviate the great inconvenience arising from there being so many persons known by his present name, and hath prayed for an act for that purpose, and it is expedient to grant the said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The said John Carson shall hereafter be called and known by the name of John Wallace Carson, and, by the latter name, shall hereafter claim, exercise and enjoy all
