C H A P . 22

An Act to amend the Quebec Game Laws.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 2313 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as R. S: 2313, amended by the act 1 George V., (1st session), chapter 18, am. section 1, is further amended:

a. By replacing paragraph 1 by the following:

“1. Any beaver at any time after the first of April, 1913, ^{Taking &c. of} to the first day of November 1917, and thereafter between ^{beaver.} the first day of April and the first day of November of any year.”

b. By striking out all the words following the word “year” in the third line of paragraph 2;

c. By replacing the words “first day of December” in the second line of paragraph 3 by the words “fifteenth day of October.”

2. Article 2315 of the said statutes, as amended by the ^{Id., 2315, am.} act 1 George V, (1st session), chapter 18, section 2, is further amended by replacing the figures “1912” in the third line of the first paragraph by the figures “1917”.

3. Article 2320 of the said statutes, is amended by adding ^{Id., 2320, am:} at the end of paragraph 4, the following: “Nevertheless this prohibition shall apply in the county of Chicoutimi until ^{Chicoutimi.} the first day of November 1917.”

4. Article 2326 of the said statutes is amended by replacing ^{Id., 2326, am:} the first paragraph by the following:

“**2326.** Heads of lumbering establishments, and foremen, ^{Responsi-} contractors and sub-contractors engaged in lumbering ^{bility of certain} operations and in the building of railways, are responsible for ^{employers.} all offences against the game laws committed by men under their control.”

Id., 2332, am: **5.** Article 2332 of the said statutes, as amended by the act 1 George V, (2nd session), chapter 26, section 2, is further amended by inserting after the word "after" in the fifth line of paragraph 1, the words: "the third day following".

Id., 2338, am. **6.** Article 2338 of the said statutes, is amended by replacing the twenty-first, twenty-second and twenty-third lines by the following:

" Articles 2313 and 2320 in the case of any other
 animal than a hare..... 30 to 50
 Articles 2313 and 2320, in the case of a female an
 additional fine of..... 10
 Articles 2313 and 2320 in the case of a hare..... 2 to 10"

Id., 2350, am. **7.** Article 2350 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :

Floating of timber. " The lease shall not prevent the holder of the timber license from doing with the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and on the conditions that he may impose and under the direction of the department of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries, the necessary work for the floating of timber on all lands, lakes or rivers leased to persons or clubs for hunting or fishing purposes."

Coming into force. **8.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 23

An Act to amend the Education Act respecting the monthly fees.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 2745, replaced. **1.** Article 2745 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is replaced by the following:

Abolition of fees. "**2745.** School commissioners and trustees may, by resolution, abolish the monthly fee.

Duration of resolution. Such resolution shall remain in force until set aside by another resolution establishing a monthly fee."

Id., 2931, am. **2.** Article 2931 of the said statutes as amended by the act 3 Geo. V, chapter 25, section 2, is amended by striking out paragraph 6.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
