An Act respecting the Polytechnic School

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

57 V., c. 23,

1. Section 17 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 23, as amended by the acts 3 Edward VII, chapter 17, section 4; 7 Edward VII, chapter 28, section 1; 8 Edward VII, chapter 31, section 1; 9 Edward VII, chap. 35, section 1, and 1 George V (2nd session), chapter 30, section 2, is further amended by replacing the word "twenty-five," in the fourth line by the word "thirty."

An Act to amend the act to incorporate the Polytechnic School.

1. Section 19 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 23, is replaced by the following :

Diplomas for
students of
Polytechnic
School.

" 19. Laval University, shall, in accordance with its charter, deliver to the students of the Polytechnic School, the diploma of Civil Engineer, Mining Engineer, Electrical Engineer, Railway Engineer, Chemical Engineer, Mechanical Engineer, Industrial Engineer, Architectural Engineer, Master in Decorative Art, and other diplomas according to the special course followed by each student.

Contents of
diplomas.

Each diploma shall mention that the student has passed the examinations during his course with distinction, or great distinction, or the greatest distinction, according to the internal regulations of the School.

Rights of
diploma
holders.

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, such diploma shall confer upon the recipients, both for the past and future, all
