An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting the appointment of coroners for the island of Anticosti.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The following article is inserted in the Revised Statutes, R. S. Q., 1909, after article 3487: 3487a, added.

“**3487a.** It shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to separate the island of Anticosti from the district of Saguenay, for the purposes of coroners’ inquests, and to appoint one or more coroners for the island of Anticosti, with such exclusive or concurrent territorial jurisdiction as he may be pleased to assign him or them. It shall also be lawful for him, if the requirements of administration demand it, to re-annex the island of Anticosti to the district of Saguenay.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting exhibitions of moving pictures.
