Extension of " **3290n.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may extend,  
jurisdiction of Juvenile by proclamation the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Delinquents'

Court. ested respecting the matters mentioned in section 2 of the Act

## C H A P. 40

An Act to amend the Cities and Towns' Act respecting the  
payment of members of the Council.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legis-  
lative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Que-  
bec, enacts as follows:

R.S., 5317, **1.** Article 5317 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended  
am. by adding thereto the following paragraph:

Payment of "Nevertheless the council of any municipality, may by a  
members of two-thirds vote of the whole of its members, enact a by-law  
council. to provide remuneration, but such by-law shall only have  
force and effect after the same is approved by the majority of  
proprietors who are municipal electors, who may vote at the  
election, and such vote shall be taken in the manner and  
subject to the procedure for the approval of loans."
