

## C H A P, 47

An Act to amend article 1220 of the Civil Code.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 1220 of the Civil Code as amended by the acts 62 Victoria, chapter 49, section 1, and 9 Edward VII, chapter 70, section 1, is further amended by inserting after the word "authenticated" in the third line of paragraph 5, the words: "before one of His Majesty's ambassadors, chargé d'affaires or consuls in a foreign country or."

## C H A P. 48

An Act to amend article 2161 of the Civil Code respecting the keeping of the entry book in registry offices.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 2161 of the Civil Code as amended by section 1 of the act 2 Edward VII, chapter 39, is further amended by adding to paragraph 3 the following sub-paragraph:

"The same entries shall be made as regards a document deposited for cancellation, except as regards the general description of the immoveable to which it relates, when such document does not contain it."
