An Act to allow Louis Feiczewicz to change his surname from Feiczewicz to Fitch.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Louis Feiczewicz, advocate, of the city and district of Montreal, has by his petition set forth his desire to change his surname from Feiczewicz to Fitch, on account of the difficulty of spelling and pronouncing his surname, and has prayed for the passing of an act for that purpose, and that it is expedient to grant the said prayer:

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and the consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The said Louis Feiczewicz shall hereafter be called and known by the name of Louis Fitch, and by the latter name shall hereafter claim, exercise and enjoy all advantages, benefits, rights and titles which, without such change of name, he would have been entitled to claim, exercise or enjoy; and all contracts, covenants and agreements made and entered into by him, by and under the name of Louis Feiczewicz shall avail to and be binding on him and be deemed entered into by him under the name of Louis Fitch, and all legacies or bequests contained in any will made in his favour by the name of Louis Feiczewicz shall avail to him as if the name of Louis Fitch had been mentioned therein, and also by the latter name he shall recover, have, hold and possess and be capable of inheriting all real or personal property and rights of any nature or kind whatsoever, which he may at present have, hold or possess or which hereafter he may be capable of inheriting, recovering, holding or possessing as fully and for the same extent as if the change of name had not hereby been made.

2. If any suit or legal or equitable proceeding has been commenced by or against the said Louis Fitch, by his former name, such suit or proceedings shall not be affected nor any relief or recovery sought thereby prevented by reason of any such change of name, but the same may be continued and carried on to judgment and execution, and until satisfaction and discharge be had as if this act had not been passed.

3. All rights and privileges generally of whatever nature and kind soever that may be hereby acquired by the said Louis Fitch, and which hereafter may be acquired under this act, shall apply to his children and descendants.

Coming into

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
