CHAP. 129

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Joseph Cohen amongst its members.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

WHEREAS Joseph Cohen, of the city of Montreal, hath Preamble.
by his petition represented:

That he was admitted to the study of advocate, on Sciences,
at the examination held in July 1911, and on Letters, at the
examination held in January 1912;

That in September 1909, he entered McGill University,
Montreal, and there followed a regular course of law, and in
May 1912, obtained the degree of Bachelor of Civil Law;

That he was under notarial indenture to Mr. Samuel William
Jacobs, King's Counsel, of the city of Montreal, since the 1st
of September 1909;

That he has successfully passed the examination for admis-
sion to the practice of advocate in July 1912;

That he has obtained the approval of the General Council
of the Bar of the Province of Quebec to a bill authorizing the
said Bar to admit him to the practice of his profession, and
the secretary of the said council to grant him his certificate
as an advocate from the time of the sanctioning of this act.

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed
for the above purposes and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

CHAP. 130

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Lyon William Jacobs amongst its members.

[Assented to 21st December, 1912]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Lyon William Jacobs of the city of Montreal hath by his petition represented:

That he was admitted to the study of advocate:

On sciences at the examination held in July, 1905;

On letters at the examination held in January 1912:

That on the 10th day of September 1907 he entered McGill University, Montreal, and there followed a regular course of law, and in May 1911 he obtained the degree of Bachelor of Civil Law;

That he was under notarial indenture to Mr. Alexander L. Bonin, advocate, of the city of Montreal, since the 1st December, 1907;

That he successfully passed the examination for admission to the practice of advocate, July 2nd, 1912;

That he has obtained the approval of the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec to a bill authorizing the said Bar to admit him to the practice of his profession and the secretary of the said council to grant him his certificate as an advocate from the time of the sanctioning of the said act by the Legislature.
