C H A P . 1 3

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting the reduction in the number of hotel licenses in the towns of Marieville and Acton Vale.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1912.]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec enacts as follows:

**1.** Paragraph 4 of article 943 of the Revised Statutes, R.S.Q., 943, 1909, as amended by the acts 1 George V (1st session), chapter 10, section 4, 1 George V (2nd session), chapter 15, section 1, and 2 George V, chapter 12, section 1, is further amended by inserting at the end thereof the words: "In the town of Marieville the number of hotel licenses is limited to a maximum of two (the present number), and shall not, hereafter, be increased to three unless the population of the said municipality shall have reached three thousand souls, and so on thereafter, the increase being limited to a maximum of one for each one thousand souls of the population; in the town of Acton Vale the number of hotel licenses is limited to a maximum of two (the present number), and shall not, hereafter, be increased to three unless the population of the said municipality shall have reached three thousand souls, and so on thereafter, the increase being limited to a maximum of one for each one thousand souls of the population."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
