

## C H A P . 1 4

An Act to amend the Quebec Succession Duties Act.

[*Assented to 3rd April, 1912.*]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- R.S.Q., 1375, am.      **1.** Article 1375 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended:
- a. By replacing the word "five" in the first line of the first clause "a" of paragraph 1, by the word "fifteen";
  - b. By repealing the first clause "b" of paragraph 1;
  - c. By replacing the word "ten" in the first line of the first clause "c" of paragraph 1 by the word "fifteen";

- Coming into force.      **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## C H A P . 1 5

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting motor vehicles.

[*Assented to 3rd April, 1912.*]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- R.S.Q., 1435, replaced.      **1.** Article 1435 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as replaced by the act 1 George V (2nd session), chapter 16, section 9, is again replaced by the following:

Application of certain revenues.      " **1435.** The revenue derived from all fees collected and penalties imposed under this section, shall be employed as far as they will go, in the manner specified in the Good Roads' Act, 1912, less such proportion thereof as may be applied, from time to time, by the Provincial Treasurer, under the direction of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, to the payment of the expenses incurred for the carrying out of the said section."

- Coming into force.      **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
