

C H A P . 2 7

An Act respecting the Catholic School Commission of the city of Montreal.

[Assented to 14th March, 1912.]

WHEREAS the Catholic School Commission of the city Preamble.
of Montreal has by its petition represented that it is necessary that it should acquire and build new schools within the territory administered by it and improve schools already built;

Whereas it prays for authorization to contract a fresh loan of five hundred thousand dollars for such purposes;

Whereas it further prays for power to make new by-laws respecting the indemnity to be paid to its members;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer to such effect contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:
