

## C H A P 44

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting registers in registry offices.

[Assented to 14th March, 1912.]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R.S.Q., 1909, 7504, am. **1.** Article 7504 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is replaced by the following:

“**7504.** The Provincial Secretary, pursuant to instructions which he may receive, from time to time, from the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, shall supply and transmit to each registry office, all the registers necessary for the carrying on of a registry office, whenever, according to a report of an inspector, one or more registers, as the case may be, are required for the proper working of the office.

How paid  
for.

The cost of such registers shall be paid out of any unappropriated moneys in the hands of the Provincial Treasurer.”

When act  
not to apply.

**2.** This act shall not apply to registrars who have supplied at their own expense the registers now in use, except in so far as and whenever new registers, are, according to the report of an inspector, needed for the good working of their offices.

Coming into  
force.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## C H A P . 45

An Act to amend article 381 of the Civil Code.

[Assented to 3rd April, 1912.]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows

**1.** Article 381 of the Civil Code is amended by inserting, after the word “habitation” in the second line, the words: “the right to cut timber perpetually or for a limited time.”

Coming into  
force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
