

CHAP. 8

An Act to detach certain lots from the county of Bellechasse and to annex them to the municipality of the eastern part of the township of Armagh, in the county of Montmagny, for all purposes.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Certain lots detached from county of Bellechasse, and annexed to county of Montmagny. **1.** Lots numbers 31 to 43 both inclusive, and part of number 44 as far as the Buteau road, of the first south-east range; 31 to 35 both inclusive of the second south-east range ; and 1 to 12, both inclusive, of the east range of La Rivière du Pin ; all of the cadastre of the township of Armagh in the county of Bellechasse, are detached from the said county and annexed for all purposes to the municipality of the east part of the township of Armagh in the county of Montmagny.

Annexation of other lots to certain municipality. Lots numbers 1 to 29, both inclusive, of range 1 of the township of Montminy, in the county of Montmagny, are detached from the municipality of St. Paul de Montminy and annexed to the municipality of the east part of the township of Armagh in the said county.

Change of name, of certain municipality. **2.** The municipality of the east part of the township of Armagh in the county of Montmagny shall in future be called " the municipality of Saint Euphémie sur Rivière du Sud."

R. S. Q., 67, am. **3.** Numbers 6 and 39 of article 67 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, are amended accordingly.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
