

C H A P . 1 5

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting the reduction of the number of licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors in the town of La Tuque.

[*Assented to 24th March, 1911*]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R.S.Q., 943, am. **1.** Paragraph 4 of article 943 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, as amended by section 4 of the act 1 George V, chapter 10, is further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following :
 “ In the town of La Tuque the number of hotel licenses is limited to a maximum of one for each one thousand of the population.”

Id., 968, am. **2.** Article 968 of the said statutes is amended by adding after the twenty-seventh line the following paragraph :
 “ In the town of La Tuque the number of shop licenses for the sale of liquor by retail is limited to a maximum of one for each one thousand of the population.”

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 1 6

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting motor vehicles.

[*Assented to 14th March, 1911*]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R.S.Q., 1389, am. **1.** Article 1389 of the Revised Statutes 1909 is amended by replacing the words : “ and he shall pay a registration fee of five dollars, the amount of such fee to be sent in with the application ” in the seventh, eight and ninth lines, by the following : “ and he shall pay the proper registration fee, as provided in the following tariff, the amount of such fee to be sent in with the application :
 Registration fee.
