5. In case of claims or lands situated more than fifty miles from a railway station, the Minister may, in his discretion, substitute a further annual rent of fifty cents an acre in place of the work required to be done.

6. The Minister may exercise the same discretion whenever the holder of a claim or of a license is the only person to apply for the issue or the renewal thereof. Nevertheless in case of a license required for industrial or commercial purposes only, the price shall in all cases be one dollar a year per acre, and the license shall be renewable upon filing a report in conformity with article 2162."

8. The following article is inserted in the said statutes after article 2213 ;

Notice of
accidents.

" **2213a.** If while a mine or a quarry is being worked, an accident takes place resulting in loss of life or serious injury, the person working the same or his representative at such mine or quarry, shall forthwith send a written notice to the Minister, specifying the nature of the accident, the number of persons killed or injured and their names if they are known.

Penalty.

Every person not complying with the requirements of this article, shall be liable to the penalties provided in article 2207. "

CHAP. 24

An Act to amend article 2160 of the Revised Statutes, 1909.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2160 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by adding the following paragraphs :

"Nevertheless in order to permit of the working and ex-Diverting
ploitation of alluvial lands containing gold, the Quebec Public of water for

CHAP. 25

An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries' Act.

[Assented to 14th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legisla-
tive Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec,
enacts as follows :

1. Article 2247 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended R.S.Q., 2247,
by inserting after the word "Province" in the third line of am.
paragraph 6, the words "including waters in which the fishing
rights are private or are leased from the Crown".

2. Article 2248 of the said statutes is amended by inserting Id., 2248,
after the word "therein" in the second line of paragraph 3, am.
the words: "even in waters where the fishing rights are private
or are leased from the Crown".

3. This act shall not effect pending cases.
