An act to amend the Quebec Game Laws.

[Assented to 14th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R.S.Q., 2313a, added. **1.** The following article is inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after article 2313 as amended by section 1 of the act 1 George V, chapter 18 :

Killing, &c., of beaver. “**2313a.** Notwithstanding the prohibition contained in article 2313, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries, to have beaver hunted or taken for the benefit of the Crown, in certain places where they do damage by damming lakes and rivers and flooding the neighbouring lands.”

Id., 2332, am. **2.** Article 2332 of the said statutes is amended by inserting the following clauses to paragraph 3 :

Seizure of certain skins, &c., as security. “The officer who makes a seizure in pursuance of paragraph 2 of this article, may, at the same time, seize, as security for the payment of the fine and costs, any skins, animals, or parts thereof to which this paragraph applies, and which are found with the other articles so seized.

Disposal of things seized. The articles so seized as security, shall be left in charge of the justice of the peace, until final judgment upon the complaint, and shall then be sold according to law to satisfy such fine and costs if any.”

Id., 2344, am. **3.** Article 2344 of the said statutes is amended by inserting after the word “therein” in the second line, the words “even on lands of which he is the proprietor or lessee.”

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
