An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting expropriation in connection with the building of churches and rectories.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The title of section fifth of chapter third of title ninth of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is replaced by the following :
“Expropriations for the purpose of building and enlarging churches, rectories, &c., and for cemetery purposes.”

2. Article 4419 of the said statutes is amended by inserting after the word “enlarging” in the seventh line, the words “of a church, of a sacristy, of a rectory or”

C H A P . 3 7

An act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting the Quebec Medical Act.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

Preamble.

WHEREAS, several persons have begun to follow the university course required for admission to practice medicine, before the first day of January, 1910, and before having been admitted to study ;

Whereas, inasmuch as the time during which such students have followed the said courses before having being admitted to study, does not count in the period of studentship necessary before admission to practice medicine, their admission to practice the said profession is delayed and they thereby suffer great prejudice ;

Whereas, in various cases, the Legislature, by special acts, and with the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, has remedied this state of things ;

Whereas, it is expedient that power be given to the said College of Physicians and Surgeons, to remedy the said state of things, as it may think proper, in cases where the remedy above mentioned has not been applied ;

And whereas, further, it is expedient to amend the Quebec Medical Act, respecting the admission to the practice of medicine in the Province, of the persons whose names are entered in the medical register of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. In all cases where medical students, have begun to follow the university courses required for admission to practice medicine, before the first day of January, 1910, and before having been admitted to study, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec may, by resolution of the Provincial Medical Board, declare that the time during which such students followed said courses before having been admitted to study, shall count in the period of studentship required before admission to the practice of medicine, in the same way as if they had been admitted to study before they began such courses. Provisions respecting certain medical students.

2. Notwithstanding article 4929 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, the period of studentship for such students shall be four years, and when they have followed the said courses during such period and have fulfilled all the other conditions prescribed by law, the said College of Physicians and Surgeons may admit them to the examination for admission to practice medicine, and on a report that such examination has been passed, and on presentation of an university degree of doctor of medicine, the said students shall be entitled to their licences and to the registration thereof, and may practice medicine so soon as they have obtained such licenses and registration, and taken the required oath. 3. Article 4942 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended R.S.Q., 4942, by replacing the words "in the said United Kingdom" in the fifth line of paragraph 2 by the words "outside of the Province of Quebec." am.
