

C H A P . 3 9

An Act to amend the act of this session intituled : “ An Act to amend article 5685 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and the Municipal Code, respecting bridges.”

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The act of this session intituled “ An Act to amend article 5685 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, and the Municipal Code, respecting bridges ”, and being chapter 38 shall come into force on the day of its sanction. 1 Geo. V, (2 session) c. 38. am.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

C H A P . 4 0

An act respecting bakers, and the manufacture of bread, in certain municipalities.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Notwithstanding any law or by-law to the contrary, all bread sold or made for sale within the limits of the Province shall be made of good and wholesome flour and baked in loaves of one, two, three, four, five or six pounds or more, but without any fraction of a pound above the pound ; and the said bread must have one of the weights aforesaid eight hours after having been baked, sold or exposed for sale. How bread to be baked, &c.

2. Nevertheless, in cities and towns, any bread may be made and sold by weight, but it shall bear a label of three quarters of an inch square mentioning the exact weight and the baker's name. Sale of bread in cities and towns.

3. Bread weighing not more than twelve ounces and bearing no label may be made in the Province. Bread if not more than 12 ounces &c
