

- Penalty.      **4.** Every person carrying on the business or industry of a baker contrary to the provisions of this act, is guilty of an offence and is liable for each offence to a fine of not more than twenty dollars, and, in default of payment, to imprisonment of not more than thirty days.
- Procedure.    **5.** Prosecutions taken in pursuance of this act shall be taken, tried and decided in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Code, except in cities and towns which shall remain subject to the provisions of their respective charters or of the Cities and Towns' Act.
- Coming into force.    **6.** This act shall come into force on the first day of May 1911.

C H A P . 4 1

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting electric light and power companies.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

- 1.** The following section and article are inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after section eighth of chapter third of title eleventh.

SECTION VIIIa

“ ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER COMPANIES

Application of 6237 to certain companies.

“ **6238a.** The provisions of article 6237, apply *mutatis mutandis*, to incorporated electric light or power companies, or to incorporated electric light and power companies. ”
