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G.—(*Article 7522.*)

*Inspectors' Oath of Office.*

I, A. B., appointed inspector of registry offices in the Province of Quebec, solemnly swear I will faithfully perform and execute the duties of such office according to law : So help me God.”

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## CHAP. 50

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting the making of rules of practice.

[*Assented to 14th March, 1911*]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly, of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 37 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by inserting after the word “ coroners ” in the third line, the word “ bailiffs. ”

**2.** Article 73 of the said code is amended by replacing the *Id.*, 73, *am.* words " at least two thirds " in the second line of paragraph 2, by the words " the majority ".

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. *Coming into force*

## CHAP. 51

An Act to amend article 684 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

[*Assented to 24th March, 1911*]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 684 of the Code of Civil Procedure, is amended *C. C. P., 684, am.* by adding the following paragraph :

" The attorney of a garnishee in virtue of a general or special power of attorney may make such declaration in the stead of the garnishee and with the same effect; but the seizing creditor may thereafter, on motion, obtain from the judge or the prothonotary an order for the personal appearance and examination of the garnishee." *Declaration by attorney of garnishee, &c.*

## CHAP. 52

An Act to amend article 781 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

[*Assented to 24th March, 1911*]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 781 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended *C. C. P., 781, am.* by adding the following paragraph :

" 4. Hypothecs given in favour of the city of Three Rivers in virtue of the act 9 Edward VII, chapter 84. " *Hypothecs, Three Rivers.*

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. *Coming into force.*
