

## C H A P . 5 3

An act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting the jurisdiction of the clerk of the Circuit Court.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. C. P., 1126, **1.** Article 1126 of the Code of Civil Procedure as amended  
amended. by the acts 63 Victoria, chapter 43, section 1 and 1 George V, chapter 43, section 7, is further amended by adding the following paragraph :

Powers of clerk of C. C. &c. “The powers granted to the prothonotary by article 70 may be exercised, in matters within his jurisdiction, by the clerk of the Circuit Court or, in his absence, by the deputy clerk appointed by him for that purpose, with the consent of the Attorney-General.”

## C H A P . 5 4

An Act to amend article 1150 of the Code of Civil Procedure.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. C. P., 1150, **1.** Article 1150 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended  
am. by adding thereto the following paragraph :

Alimentary allowances. “15. Actions for the recovery of alimentary allowances.”

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
