

CHAP. 62

An Act to ratify a by-law dated 8th June 1910, adopted by the city of Three Rivers, respecting the granting of privileges to the Diamond Whitewear Company, Limited.

[*Assented to 14th March, 1911*]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Diamond Whitewear Company, Limited, has, by its petition, prayed for an act to confirm and ratify the by-law adopted by the corporation of the city of Three Rivers on the 8th June 1910, and the approval thereof by the municipal electors on the 13th June 1910, such by-law being intituled : "Chapter 196. A by-law to authorize the council of the city of Three Rivers to vote and grant to Messrs James N. Greenshields and John Oppe, or their representatives, for the establishment of a whitewear factory in this city, an aid or bonus to the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars, and to issue bonds for such purpose, and also to fix the amount of municipal taxes on the said factory, during a period of ten consecutive years, at the sum of three hundred dollars per annum for five years and four hundred dollars for five other years";

Whereas the said company has, by its petition, represented that doubts have arisen as to the validity of the said by-law and its ratification especially as regards the power of the corporation to issue bonds as therein provided; and

Whereas it is expedient to remove such doubts ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Certain by-law ratified.

1. The by-law, bearing the number 196, adopted by the corporation of the city of Three Rivers on the 8th June, 1910, and the ratification thereof at a public meeting in the city hall of the city of Three Rivers on the 13th June, 1910, and all the powers, rights and privileges in and by the said by-law granted to the said Diamond Whitewear Company, Limited, are hereby ratified, confirmed and declared legal and valid.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
