

## CHAP. 88

An Act to amend the act to incorporate *La Compagnie d'Assurance Mutuelle des Industries*.

[Assented to 24th March, 1911]

**W**HEREAS *La Compagnie d'Assurance Mutuelle des Industries* Preamble.  
*tries* has, by its petition, represented that it is desirable that the act incorporating it be amended for the purposes hereinafter set forth, and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Section 1 of the act 8 Edward VII, chapter 126, is replaced by the following : 8 Ed. VII., c. 126, s. 1, replaced.

“**1.** David Levesque, manufacturer, of the parish of St. Philémon, county of Bellechasse; Pierre Nicole, manufacturer, of the parish of St. Paul, county of Montmagny; François Coulombe, manufacturer, of the parish of St. Paul, county of Montmagny; Georges Roy, manufacturer, of Notre-Dame du Rosaire, county of Montmagny; Arthur Lemieux, manufacturer, of Ste. Euphémie, county of Montmagny; Louis Roy, manufacturer, of Ste. Euphémie, county of Montmagny; Eugène Tremblay, manufacturer, of St. François, county of Montmagny; Jean Baptiste Normand, manufacturer, of the town of Montmagny; Joseph Thibault, manufacturer, of the town of Montmagny, and all manufacturers who may join them for the aforesaid purposes are constituted a corporation under the name of “*L'Assurance des Industries Compagnie Mutuelle*” Name.

**2.** Section 10 of the said act is repealed.

**3.** Section 11 of the said act is replaced by the following :

“**11.** As soon as the company shall have procured a capital stock of at least two hundred thousand dollars and one tenth thereof shall have been paid into the company's funds, and as soon as it has complied with the Quebec Insurance Act, it shall be empowered to insure all kinds of property, rights and interests against loss or damage by fire or lightning under the mutual as well as under the non-mutual or cash system, enter into and execute contracts, agreements or stipulations, written or printed, or partly written and partly printed relating to such purposes and calculated to accomplish the same, the whole within the limits prescribed by the Quebec Insurance Act.” When business to be begun.

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
