

CHAP. 139

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Napoléon Jules Marion among its members, after examination.

[Assented to 14th March, 1911]

WHEREAS Napoléon Jules Marion, law student, of the ^{Preamble.} city and district of Montreal, has by his petition presented :

That he has for over two years been a law student at Laval University, Montreal, and has successfully passed the various examinations of the faculty of law of such university ;

That he has regularly attended an advocate's office for over two years ;

That he has been unable, for special reasons to present himself for examination for the admission to the study of the legal profession ;

That he has, for over two years, faithfully performed all the duties of a law student ;

That, owing to his not having been regularly admitted to study, he is exposed to lose all the benefits of his legal studies ;

That the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, on the 4th August 1910, approved of the passing of an act authorizing the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit the petitioner among its members, notwithstanding the fact of his not having been admitted to study ;

* Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the above purposes and it is expedient to grant the prayer to that effect contained in the said petition ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec. enacts as follows :

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to ^{Bar of P. Q.} admit the said Napoléon Jules Marion to the final examina- ^{authorized to} tion required for admission to the practice of law, and after ^{admit N. J.} such examination, to admit him among the mmebers of the ^{Marion after} examination. ^{Bar of this Province.}

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into} force.
