

## C H A P . 1 4 0

An act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit William James Shaughnessy amongst its members.

[*Assented to 14th March, 1911*]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS William James Shaughnessy, of the city of Montreal, hath by his petition represented :

That he has followed a regular course of study in the Arts Faculty of Cambridge University, England, for three years prior to September, 1907;

That, on the first day of September, 1907, he entered Laval University, Montreal, and there followed the regular course of law and in June, 1910, obtained the degree of licentiate in law;

That he was admitted to the study of the profession of advocate at the examination held in January, 1909;

That he has been under notarial indentures to Mr. Frederick Edmund Meredith, King's Counsel, of the city of Montreal, since the first day of September, 1908;

That he has successfully passed the examination for admission to the practice of advocate in July, 1910;

That he has obtained the approval of the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec to a bill authorizing the said Bar to admit him to the practice of his profession and the secretary of the said Council to grant him his certificate as an advocate from the time of the sanctioning of the said act by the Legislature ;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the above purposes, and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**Bar of P. Q. authorized to admit W. J. Shaughnessy.**     **1.** The Bar of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to permit the said William James Shaughnessy to practice as an advocate, and the Secretary of the General Council of the Bar to issue to him his certificate as an advocate.

**Coming into force.**     **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
