1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit at its sitting to be held in July, 1911, or at any subsequent sitting, the said Joseph Armand Boisseau to the examination for admission to the practice of the notarial profession on his producing a degree of bachelor in law of Laval University, and a certificate from his patron attesting that he attended his office from the 3rd September 1907, and, after satisfactory examination, to admit him to the practice of the said notarial profession.

When to be-
gin practice.

2. The said Joseph Armand Boisseau shall not, however, commence to practise as a notary, if his examination be deemed satisfactory, before the 3rd September, 1911.

Coming into
force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 1 4 2

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to admit Charles Auguste Emond to the practice of the notarial profession, after examination.

[Assented to 14th March, 1911]

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Charles Auguste Emond, notarial student, of the parish of Vaudreuil, in the district of Montreal, has, by petition, represented :

That he followed a complete course of classical duties in the Valleyfield college, and obtained the degree of Bachelor of Sciences on the 3rd October, 1906 ;

That on the 9th October 1906, he was indentured as a student with Mr. Joseph Clavert Trudeau, notary, of the town of Beauharnois, and for two consecutive years regularly attended the office of his patron until the month of September, 1908 ;

That, in the month of September, 1908, he entered the law faculty of Laval University, at Montreal, and for two consecutive years also regularly attended the lectures of the the said faculty, and passed all the examinations required by the rules of the said faculty, while at the same time attending the office of Mr. Lucien Giroux, notary, in Montreal ;

That, through error and forgetfulness, he neglected to present himself with the above mentioned diploma before the Board of Notaries, at its session in July 1907, to be admitted to the study of the notarial profession, and to request that his

clerkship should date from the 9th day of October 1906, according to law and the rules of the Board of Notaries, and it was only at the sitting of the Board of Notaries in the month of July, 1909, that he was admitted to the study of the notarial profession upon production of his diploma of Bachelor of Science ;

That the effect of such error or forgetfulness would be to make the studentship of the said petitioner count only from the sitting of July, 1909, and to make him lose the benefit of his years of studentship and of his studies from 1906 to 1909 :

That the whole is a matter of error and forgetfulness on the part of the petitioner ;

That the petitioner applied in the month of July 1906, to the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec, by petition, and thereupon the said Board of Notaries granted the said petitioner authorization to present a bill to the Legislature, in order to have his studentship count from the 9th October, 1906, the said Charles Auguste Emond having complied with the by-laws of the said Board to obtain such consent ;

That the said petitioner wishes to pass his examination before the Board of Notaries at the next sitting of the said Board in July, 1911, or at any subsequent sitting ;

Whereas the said Charles Auguste Emond has prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant his petition ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The studentship of the said Charles Auguste Emond as law student shall be deemed to have commenced on the 9th October, 1906, and the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit, at its sitting in July 1911, or at any subsequent sitting, the said Charles Auguste Emond to the examination for admission to the practice of the notarial profession, upon his producing a certificate from the secretary of Laval University, Montreal, attesting that the said Charles Auguste Emond attended law lectures for two years, and also a certificate from his patron, the said Joseph Clavert Trudeau, attesting that he attended his office *bona fide* from the 9th October 1906 to the month of September, 1908, and a certificate from any other patron, stating that he has *bona fide* attended his office since the latter date, and, after a satisfactory examination, it may admit him to the practice of the said notarial profession.
