

CHAP. 2

An Act to grant a subsidy to aid in the establishment and maintenance of forestry education in the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to grant a subsidy to aid in the maintenance in the Province of Quebec of forestry education of a nature to train men competent to assure the control and management of forests belonging to the Crown or to private persons;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Grant in aid of forestry education.

1. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, may, upon the conditions which may be arranged between the latter and *Le Syndicat Financier de l'Université Laval* at Quebec, grant to the said syndicate a sum of four thousand dollars for the school year of 1910–1911, and a sum of five thousand dollars for each subsequent school year, in order to aid in the establishment and maintenance of forestry education in the Province of Quebec.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 3

An Act to amend the acts 6 Edward VII, chapter 4, and 8 Edward VII, chapter 5

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Cutting of certain timber subject to certain regulations.

1. The following section is inserted in the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 4, after section 7 :

“ **7a.** Timber cut on lands granted by way of subsidy, in virtue of this act, is subject to any regulation ordering the manufacture thereof within the Dominion of Canada which the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may enact.”
