CHAP. 12

An Act to amend the Quebec Succession Duties' Act

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S. Q. 1375 amended. **1.** Paragraph 4 of article 1375 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is repealed.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 13

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes 1909, respecting agricultural societies

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S. Q. 1795 amended. **1.** Article 1795 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following :

Certain counties divided for agricultural purposes. “ **1795.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may divide each of the counties of Bonaventure, Charlevoix, Huntingdon, Montmorency, Rimouski, Beauce, and the Magdalen Islands, into two parts called A and B, and the counties of Gaspé and Pontiac into three parts called A, B and C.”

Id. 1825, replaced. **2.** Article 1825 of the said statutes, is replaced by the following :
