

CHAP. 23

An Act respecting the Protestant Board of School Commissioners of the City of Montreal.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

WHEREAS Laurier and de Lorimier wards have been annexed to the City of Montreal for municipal but not for school purposes; and Preamble.

Whereas it is expedient that the said wards shall as regards all Protestants residing or having property therein be added to and form part of the school municipality subject to the control of the Protestant Board of School Commissioners of the City of Montreal.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. From and after the first day of July, 1910, Laurier and de Lorimier wards of the City of Montreal shall, as regards all Protestants residing therein or having property therein, be added to and form part of the school municipality under the jurisdiction and control of the Protestant Board of School Commissioners of the City of Montreal, and the Protestant school boards in said wards shall cease to exist except for the purpose of winding up their affairs, and all rights, property, debts and obligations of the said boards shall vest in and be assumed by the Board of Protestant School Commissioners of the City of Montreal; provided however, that nothing in this act shall deprive any person who, at the time of such annexation was a creditor of either of the said school boards, of any right, remedy, privilege or recourse which he would have had or could have exercised if this act had not come into force. Laurier and de Lorimier wards annexed to the school municipality of Montreal as regards Protestants.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
